## Musical equipment retailer

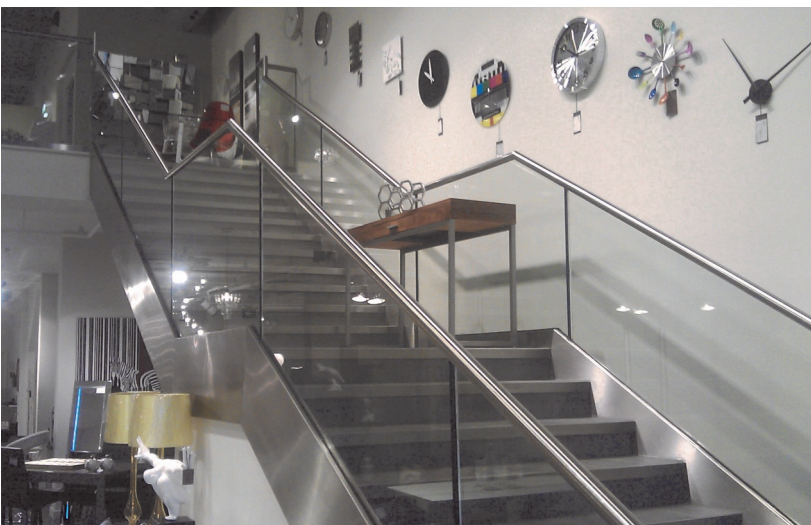
Installation of a single storey mezzanine floor to create a new, two storey 1,300m<sup>2</sup> music superstore in Bournemouth for Absolute Music.

All requirements for regulatory fire protection were incorporated into the design, including the installation of a galvanized exterior fire escape at the rear of the building.

## Furniture retailer

A single tier mezzanine floor, expanding the sales floor for this furniture retailer by a further 1,234m<sup>2</sup>.

Two stainless steel and glass feature staircases take centre stage, giving an attractive and modern look. Fire protection is incorporated within the floor column casings and suspended ceilings to comply with Building Regulations.



## Home accessories retailer

With this retailer situated on the first floor of the Bluewater shopping complex, consideration had to be given to the logistics of moving materials and building this single storey mezzanine whilst working within Bluewater's tight access constraints and noise controls.

The floor features a stainless steel and glazed staircase with toughened and laminated glass to comply with Bluewater's terrorism policy.
